Please refer to Table 2 for the relevant content. 3. The private sector includes only private schools. 4. GNI and GDP data are published by the Directorate-General of Budget Accounting and Statistics, Executive Yuan in February 2024. 5. Self-help fundraising include the National University Endowment Fund's self-help fundraising, the National University Hospital Operating Fund's and self-help fundraising expenses related to teaching and research, and the National Senior High School Affairs Fund's self-help fundraising. However, above funds don't cover depreciation. And the National High School Affairs Fund has been included since fiscal year 2007.
